

# Telemark Ski Camp Mt. Baker, Washington State

July 12-17, 1992

This adventure ski camp was organized and lead byDick Hall, founder and director of North American Telemark Organization (NATO). Some of you have seen him in "The Telemark Movie" and "Revenge of the Telemarker." Dick was assisted by Steve Hindman of Bellingham, Washington. These are two of the finest expert telemark instructors I have encountered.

Mt. Baker has the plushest corn snow in the world. I have never before experienced such veluet corn snow. Rather then provide explicit details of and telemark technique gained in this adventure, much of which I plan to pass along as we ski together this season, I would like to share an excerpt from my journal dated July 16th:

"Today I reached a point of being so coordinated, so

completely balanced, that I felt I could do anything—anything at all. I could goof around; I could put myself in an impossible position and then pull out of it, simply because I felt ... happy. an extra bit of confidence like that can carry you through and you can do things that are just about impossible. You are the skis and the skis are you. Out of this bond comes a power that allows me to take control of what otherwise might be an uncontrollable situation. There is nothing like it—I was aware of where I was and what I was doing, but my mind was on skiing with an intense, internal sense of rightness."
